Roy Tomlinson - North Devon & Torridge Housing Crisis Group

- North Devon and Torridge Housing Crisis Group
 - Established in 2021 in response to the growing crisis in housing throughout North Devon and Torridge
 - o Run via a Facebook campaign group with over 3,000 members
 - o Supporting local people to find housing, or overcome housing issues
 - o Gathering local intelligence on the issues affecting residents
 - Persistent feedback is that local salaries don't match the cost of housing (rental or to buy)
 - Widening gap between 'decent' housing available
 - Young people increasingly view North Devon as unattainable in terms of growing up and staying here into young adulthood
 - Housing is seen as an investment/open only to those who are economically enabled, not as a basic human need
 - ND & T Housing Crisis Group have created a manifesto which they have put to local and central Government tiers setting out asks:
 - To end the tax advantage of holiday lets over long term rental
 - To properly regulate holiday lets
 - To heavily tax or requisition empty properties
 - To end 'right to buy' for social housing
 - To build social housing on all available Council and Gov't land
 - To make all new builds only available to local residents

Other discussion points from the meeting

- Review of the comments/feedback from the world café on the C&P Action Group ToR/objectives:
 - Housing objective needs to be reviewed and with Board guidance on how best to take any actions forward
 - Include 'built environment' in the Environment objective
 - Consider removing 'Culture' as an objective given the establishment of the northern Devon Cultural Board – and associated action plans/strategy – this could be a separate Action Group directly under NDF Board
 - Review geographical split in representation for North Devon and Torridge
 - Consider further representation for housing and new representation for environment due to Andy Bell now taking up the Chair's role on the Climate Action Group

- Terms of Reference were updated following world café feedback and groups discussion
- Marie/Dom reviewing the upcoming meeting formats and themed guest speakers
- Action Group members discussed the forming of the action plan but real concerns as to what goes into this – existing work or just gaps, how are these identified, where will the resource come from?

- What workflow would the Board want C&P Action Group to focus on –
 'task and finish' style activity? How is this captured in an action plan that doesn't duplicate existing work?
- Would the Board agree that a new Action Group on Culture is a good way forward and agree to Officers setting this up
